



## **SEASCAPE CERT- NEIGHBOR BULLETIN #3 WHAT TO DO ON THE DAY OF A DISASTER**

*On the Day of a Disaster in Seascapes, check your house and people fill out your Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey, and tack the top half onto your front door. Go to Seascapes Park, register with CERT, and submit the bottom half of your Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey to CERT. Contact Jean at [jean@seascapecert.org](mailto:jean@seascapecert.org) to get a Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey. These are the questions you will answer on your Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey.*

- **Is anyone in the house injured?**  
If YES, bring the person to Seascapes Park to the triage area and tell a CERT team member about the injury. If you can't bring the person, go to Seascapes Park and tell a CERT member about the injury.
- **Is there a fire in your house?**  
If YES and it is small (like a campfire), put it out with your fire extinguisher. If YES and it is a large fire, evacuate the house, fight the fire after evacuation. Notify CERT people at Seascapes Park about the fire.
- **Do you smell gas in your house?**  
If YES, do not use matches, candles, electrical switches, plugs, flashlights or other spark producers. Go outside and turn off the gas at the meter, turn off the electricity from outside, only if you smell gas. If NO, do not turn off the gas at the meter. Go to Seascapes Park and tell a CERT person about gas.
- **Is there water leaking anywhere in your house?**  
If YES, fill your tubs and sinks and then shut off the water at the main.
- **Is everything OK and you will be staying in your home?**  
If YES, tack your *Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey* onto your front door. Go to Seascapes Park – register with CERT and submit the copy of your *Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey* to CERT.
- **Is everything OK and you will be leaving your home?**  
Tack your *Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey* onto your front door and turn off the electricity at the meter before you leave. Go to Seascapes Park –register with CERT and submit your *Seascapes CERT Disaster House Survey* to a CERT team member.

The Seascapes Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) members are trained to prepare and respond to a natural disaster. We need more people CERT-trained in Seascapes. Please contact Capt.
